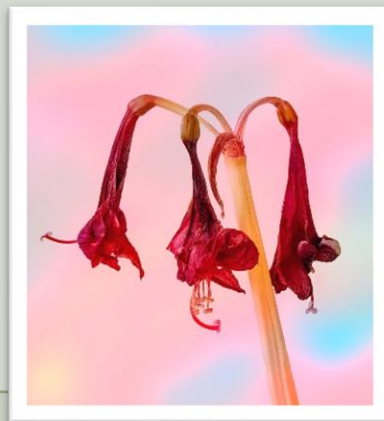
The weather was not too favourable for photographers in January, although there were some wonderful sunrises, and one or two frosty mornings – let's hope February will offer us something better.
